The poet Lord Byron has gone down in history as “mad, bad and dangerous to know” – but he came from a long line of scandalous ancestors.

Emily Brand uncovers the misdeeds of his Nottinghamshire relatives during the turbulent 18th century, including William the ‘Wicked’. This Lord Byron had an illustrious career winding up the gentry of Retford. This ultimately led to a fatal duel and a sensational murder trial in 1765.

Emily Brand is an author and historian specialising in the ‘long’ 18th century. Her book *The Fall of the House of Byron* was selected as BBC Radio 4 Book of the Week, and a Sunday Times, Mail on Sunday and BBC History Magazine Book of the Year.

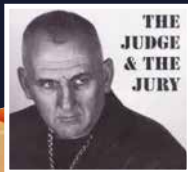

**Steve Greaves is a fascinating character. Born and raised in the 1950s in the mining town of Dinnington, South Yorkshire, Steve has gained a reputation for his charity work and for some of his earlier career exploits.**

Steve has written two autobiographies. He will recount some of the many stories of his life. People say he has been a drug dealer, handled stolen goods, had bare knuckle fights and broken bones but he also mentored youngsters at his self-built boxing gym, keeping them off the streets and giving them a sense of purpose as well as 42 years running to raise money for children via his charity Kids@heart.

An enigma then. Today he is the holder of two world records for running, achieved through a single minded, self-brutalising, desire to achieve for the benefit of others.

Graham Bartlett spent 30 years in the Brighton and Hove police working as a senior homicide detective, a chief superintendent and a public order and firearms commander. He is now a best-selling crime fiction and non-fiction author. He also works as an adviser on police procedure for crime writers and TV dramas.

His debut non-fiction, *Death Comes Knocking*, written with Peter James, was a Sunday Times Top Ten bestseller, and Peter and Graham followed this up with the critically acclaimed *Babes in the Wood*. Since then, Graham has had three solo crime novels published; *Bad for Good* (Sunday Times Top Ten Best Seller, Winner of Crime Fiction Lover Editors' Choice Award 2022 and Nominated for Specsavers Debut of the Year 2022), *Force of Hate*, and *City on Fire*.

As a police procedure and crime advisor, Graham works with over 200 authors and TV writers (including Peter James, Elly Griffiths, Anthony Horowitz, Ruth Ware, Mark Billingham and the BBC), helping them inject authenticity into their work. He is a crime writing mentor with Jericho Writers, runs live and online crime writing courses, is a regular speaker at crime writing festivals and appears in many true crime TV documentaries.
